

Rules of the Snookersport Club (shortened)

The Snookersport Club is a place for sport and relaxation of its members. By following these rules, every member expresses his/her respect and kindness towards other members. The rules set the boundaries of the club members behaviour in a way that all can use club equipment and relax in an enjoyable atmosphere.

1. The member of the club enters the club decently and cleanly dressed. He/she uses the playing tables in a clean state to avoid making them dirty.
2. The whole club is strictly non smoking. Only the closed saloon is an exception, where it is possible to smoke at the tables with ashtrays.
3. The member takes care of the tables and avoids causing any damage. He/she never sits on the tables. Only a player preparing for a shot can lean on the table.
4. Before starting the game, the member must register himself with the staff on duty by providing his/hers membership card.
5. During the game, a member behaves in such a way as to not disturb the other players with any noise or movement. He/she restricts mobile phone usage to a minimum and turns down the ringing volume.
6. If he/she uses additional equipment, like rests or extensions, they must be returned to their originating places.
7. After the end of the game, he returns the balls, chinks and cues to the staff on duty.
8. The drinks bought in our cafe can be consumed only in the cafe area, or on the tables in the playing area that are intended for that purpose. It is strictly forbidden to put drinks on the playing tables or move them above the tables. Breaking this rule results in a fine of €100
9. Snacks can only be consumed in the cafe area.
10. A member of the club is fully responsible for the damages he causes. If a table or any other equipment is damaged, the member must immediately notify the staff on duty.
11. The member of the club is fully responsible for the behaviour of his/her guest.
